## MEMBERSHIP IN THE HUXFORD GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY

Full membership is open to persons age 18 or older and a husband and wife team at \$30.00 annual dues.

Members have year-round access to the Huxford Genealogical Research Library. When visiting the library members are provided assistance and guidance from staff and other members that may be present.

Members receive, the quarterly publications of the Huxford Genealogical Society Magazine, and may seek help from all members of the society through the Huxford Helper Section in the Magazine.

Members are provided an avenue to publish family sketches in the Huxford Genealogical Society Magazine, and in future volumes of Pioneers of Wiregrass Georgia, and in future publications of Florida's Suwannee-Land Pioneers. Members may also make additions and corrections to sketches previously published.

The society encourages members to attend the quarterly meetings so they may voice their opinions and recommendations, and cast their vote in matters of the society.

The society encourages members to volunteer their time and talent to assist the staff in the functions and improvement of the library. Members are encouraged to attend the monthly work days held the last week end of the month, subject to holidays. A valuable service to the Society can also be provided by those members that are unable to work at the library due to travel, etc., by volunteering to take on projects that can be mailed to them, e.g., compiling, updating and typing.

### THE HUXFORD GENEALOGICAL RESEARCH LIBRARY:

The Library is open Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

The Library is closed Christmas Eve and Christmas day, 4th of July, Labor day, and Thanksgiving day.

### RULES;

1. A non-member or families are welcomed as a guest on their first visit to the Library. They will be charged \$15.00 per day for subsequent research privileges.
2. Briefcases, bags, knapsacks, etc. must be deposited at the counter prior to beginning research.
3. The staff reserves the right to examine briefcases, bags and notes. etc.
4. Notes may be taken only with pencil, typewriter, audio recorder or portable computer.
5. Patrons are requested not to shelve books and microfilm, but place them in the reshelve-bin.
6. Copy machines are available for use at the per copy charge posted at the machines.
7. Computers and micro film readers are available for use at a per CD or per roll viewing time frame when other visitors express their desire to use the equipment. A computer print out or a microfilm copy may be made at the per copy charge posted at the machines.
8. Blank log sheets are available at the desk for use in logging and tallying copies made. Payment for copies should be made 15 minutes prior to closing time.
9. Smoking is prohibited in the library and the building complex.
10. Eating and drinking is permitted only in the small kitchen area. A refrigerator, also small may be used to store a perishable snack and drink.
11. In that researching can be frustrating and at times mind-boggling we ask that all visitors please refrain from loud discussions.

## GUIDE TO SHELF NUMBERING SYSTEM

Source materials are shelved in sections and are identified by a two or three-line code.

- LINE 1..SECTION:** Alpha..Identifies..A Particular Grouping.  
 Examples.. America 'Whence We Came.' AME  
 Colonist..AME-Col - Emigrants..AME-Emi - Nobility..AME-Nob, etc.  
 Family Records, Files, Histories, and Sketches...See Book I FR  
 Getting A Start In Genealogical Research. GAS  
 Nations..France..NAT-Fra - Germany..NAT-Ger - Ireland..NAT-Ire, etc. NAT+ID  
 United States of America, USA  
 States..US Postal Code. e.g. Alabama-AL-Florida-FL - Georgia-GA. etc.  
 State and County. e.g. Florida-Duval..FL-Duv - Georgia-Clinch..GA-Cli.
- LINE 2..CATEGORY:** Alpha-numeric..Use to organize records into categories.  
 Examples.. Census-Cr. Death-Dr. Marriage-Mr. Other-Or, OrG. Publication In Series-PIS.
- SUB-CATEGORY:** A provision that may be used to better organize large volumes of records or an anticipation of in Sections: AL, FL, GA, NC, SC, USA, and VA.  
 Examples.. Other Records General-OrG, Other Records Military-OrM, Other Records Native American-OrN, Other Records Religious-OrR, The South-OrS. etc.
- SUB-CLASS:** The last four-characters line 2 may be used to designate a Sub-Classification within a Category.  
 Examples.. Dr..Death Sub-classification, Cemetery records.. Dr-Cem  
 Or, OrG..Other Sub-classification, Church records.. Or-Chu or OrG-Chu  
 Or, OrG..Other Sub-classification, Judicial records.. Or-Jud or OrG-Jud  
 OrM..Military Sub-classification, Civil War.. OrM-Civ  
 OrM..Military Sub-classification, War of 1812.. OrM-1812
- LINE 3..DOCUMENT:** Alpha-numeric. Identifies a specific document.  
 First-three-characters are normally the first-three-letters of the first-word in the title. Exceptions are necessary. Articles, conjunctions & prepositions may be used or ignored.  
 Fourth character.. Normally the first-letter of the second-word in the title.  
 Fifth and sixth-characters.. Identifies a specific record amongst those with the same name and/or a specific issue in multi-publications. e.g. a book, an edition, a part, or volume, etc.
- SMALL DOCUMENT:** A Box Code may be used to identify the housing of an assortment of small documents in magazine file boxes. e.g. Bx1, Bx2, etc.
